Description of corner evidence found:

D.H. Vaughan at corner in 1898. He found original BT. We found a fence line leading to an old maple stub. Local resident Carl Rollman was told by his father this was a BT. They erected a fence from the BT East. Vaughan's distance from MC east to the North  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of Section 2 was 4880.7'. Our distance is 4884.05'

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.
